Job Title: Carpenter

Summary: The carpenter is responsible for structural work, including but not limited to building/repairing stairways, door frames, wall frames, partitions, etc. on any projects assigned. Additionally, the carpenter will also install fixtures, hang cabinets, moldings, etc. on any projects assigned.

### Responsibilities and Duties:

- Directly work with the Site Superintendent to complete the project on schedule and with quality workmanship that meets the client's plans and specifications.
- Ability to correctly use a variety of tools, including but not limited to levels, chisels, sanders, circular saws, nail guns, etc.
- Ability to

- Measure, cut, or shape wood, plastic, fiberglass, drywall, and other materials
- Construct building frameworks, including wall studs, floor joists, and doorframes
